And we build our ships with the latest, most advanced waste management and water treatment plant in the industry. We control waste on board and dispose of it responsibly. Plus, we offer still and sparkling water delivered in a complimentary reusable water bottle to help reduce waste.

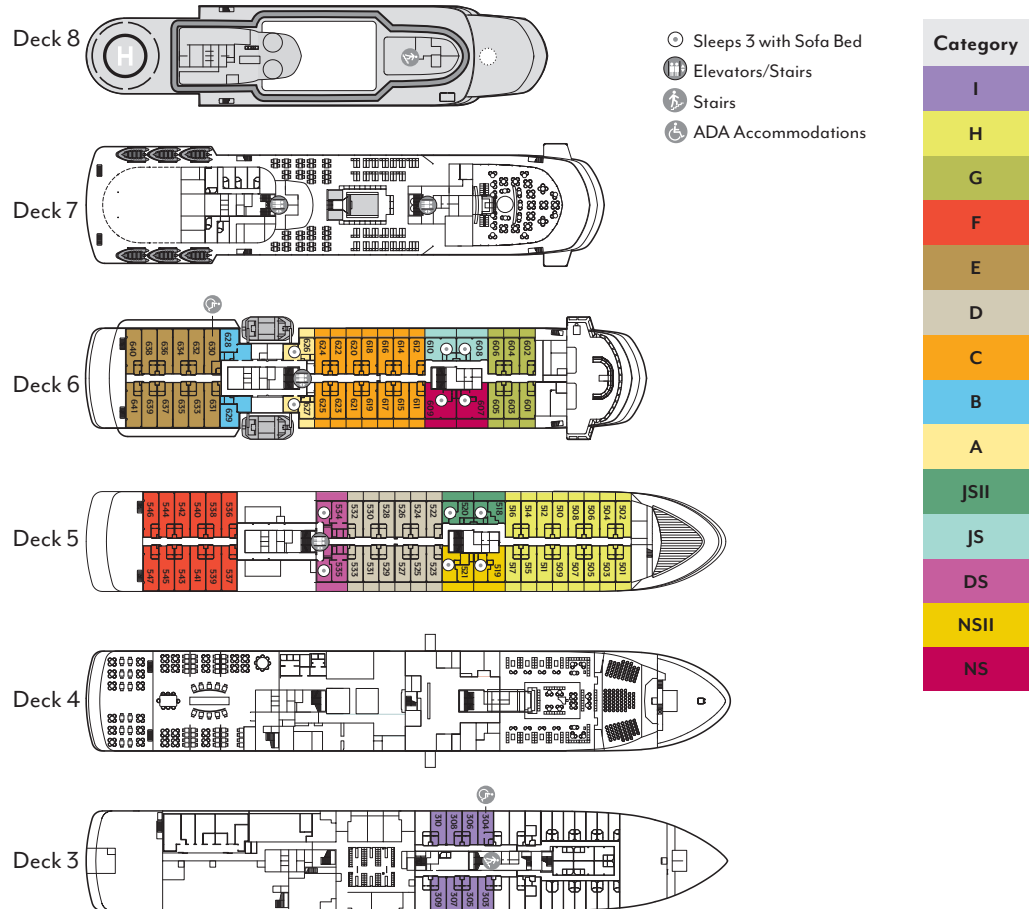
