

Day EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

Day ARRIVE IN DUBROVNIK, CROATIA –
2 EMBARKATION (R,D) Upon arriving an
Orbridge representative will be waiting
to assist with your transfer to the ship. Le
Bougainville is a masterpiece of luxury
cruising. During embarkation take time
to unpack and become familiar with your
accommodations. This evening gather for
a welcome reception and gala dinner to

celebrate the exciting journey ahead.

KOTOR, MONTENEGRO (B,L,D) Join a Day local guide for a walking tour of Kotor's iconic landmarks including the Cathedral of Saint Tryphon. Built in 1166, the cathedral was dedicated to Kotor's patron saint, Saint Tryphon—with its twin towers and Romanesque architecture dominating the skyline. Step inside to peruse the rich collection of religious artifacts, frescoes and the beautifully decorated altar. The cathedral also houses an impressive array of relics including a silver casket containing the remains of Saint Tryphon. This evening on board, delight in a gourmet dinner crafted from locally sourced ingredients expertly paired with exquisite wines. (OPT EXCURSIONS[†] Mussel and Oyster Farm Visit; Blue Cave Boat Tour)

HVAR, CROATIA (B,L,D) Immerse yourself Day in the spiritual and historical significance of Hvar during a guided walking tour. Begin in the town center at the Benedictine Monastery. Founded in the 17th century, this site is best known for its tradition of lacemaking, a craft passed down through generations of Benedictine nuns. The lace, made from agave fibers, is so exquisite that it has been recognized by UNESCO as part of the world's intangible cultural heritage. Tour the monastery's peaceful cloisters and chapel, and visit the small museum showcasing intricate lace pieces, historical artifacts and religious art. Continue to the Franciscan Monastery—a beautiful example of Dalmatian Renaissance architecture along the waterfront. (OPT EXCURSIONS† Carić Winery Tour and Tasting; Guided Stari Grad Tour)

SPLIT (B,L,D) Set off on a guided walking Day tour through Old Town. The area is 5 centered around Diocletian's Palace, an ancient Roman palace built for the Emperor Diocletian at the turn of the 4th century AD. Continue to the Cathedral of Saint Domnius, one of the oldest cathedrals in the world still in use in its original structure. Next visit the Ethnographic Museum to peruse exhibits that feature traditional costumes, textiles, tools and household items that illustrate the daily life and customs of the local people over the centuries. (OPT EXCURSIONS† Full-Day Blue Lagoon Adventure; Roman Square Food Tasting)


Day BRIJUNI ISLANDS (B,L,D) Relish in a relaxing day at the beach to swim and soak up the sunshine. Back on board take time to freshen up before visiting the main lounge for snacks and beverages accompanied by live music. (OPT EXCURSION† Half-Day Brijuni National Park Adventure)

Day RAVENNA, ITALY (B,L,D) Discover Ravenna's enchanting blend of ancient and medieval splendor during a guided tour. Once the capital of the Western Roman Empire, Ravenna boasts a rich cultural heritage. See the Basilica di San Vitale—one of Ravenna's most famous landmarks. Completed in 547 AD, this octagonal basilica is celebrated for its intricate mosaics that depict biblical scenes, saints and emperors. Continue to the Basilica di Sant'Apollinare Nuovo, originally built in the early 6th century by Theodoric the Great. (OPT EXCURSIONS† Full-Day Guided Tour of UNESCO Site Ferrara; Pomposa Abbey Visit)

Day RAVENNA (B,L,R,D) During a full-day guided 8 city tour see the historic and cultural highlights of Bologna including Piazza Maggiore's expansive square, the Basilica di San Petronio and the Archiginnasio. (OPT EXCURSION† Full-Day Emilia-Romagna Region Food Tasting Tour)

Day VENICE – DISEMBARKATION I DEPART 9 FOR U.S. (B) After breakfast take a complimentary transfer to the airport for flights home.



Prestige (Decks 4, 5, 6) approx. 204 sq. ft.

One king or two single beds, one chaise lounge chair, private bathroom with shower, panoramic sliding bay window or panoramic swing door, panoramic sliding bay window, private balcony with two armchairs.

Deluxe Suite (Decks 3, 4, 5, 6) approx. 290 sq. ft.

One king or two single beds, an armchair and sofa, private bathroom with shower, glazed panoramic swing door and panoramic window (Decks 3), panoramic sliding bay window (Decks 4, 5, 6), private balcony with two armchairs.



ARRIVE IN DUBROVNIK, CROATIA Upon arrival to
 Dubrovnik Airport transfer to the hotel. Later gather for a special welcome dinner in the town center.

Day DUBROVNIK Meet with a local guide for a panoramic city tour. First view the City Walls which +3 are among the most iconic and well-preserved fortifications in the world. Fort Lovrijenac, also known as St. Lawrence Fortress, is a standalone fortress situated on a 121-foot high cliff outside Dubrovnik's western wall. Next see the Western Outer Wall, or Predzide, which is an extension of the main city walls designed to provide an additional layer of defense. Explore displays of ancient tools at Dubrovnik's historic metallurgic casting exposition. Finally see a series of beautifully preserved rooms at the Rector's Palace and peruse the impressive collection of artifacts at the museum inside Dubrovnik's Franciscan Monastery. The remainder of the day and evening are at leisure.

Giambattista Tiepolo and his son, Giandomenico
Tiepolo. The villa is surrounded by lush gardens
offering stunning views of the surrounding
countryside. The gardens are designed in a classical
Italian style featuring manicured lawns, geometric
flower beds and statues. The highlight of the garden
is a series of 17 stone dwarf statues ("nani" in Italian)
that give the villa its name. According to local
legend, these statues represent the dwarf servants
of a noble family and add a whimsical touch to
the garden's elegance. Check in to the property in
Prosecco and relax before gathering for dinner.
