# **AAAC VOLUNTEER**

Alumni Admissions Advisory Committee (AAAC) volunteers serve as ambassadors for the university by conducting evaluative, informative, and positive interviews with prospective students applying for undergraduate admission. AAAC volunteers offer a personalized view of Duke to applicants, provide additional information about an applicant to the Admissions Office, and promote Duke's visibility in the community.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Must be a Duke alumnus/a from the undergraduate or graduate/professional school
- Must be knowledgeable about the Duke undergraduate experience
- Must not work as a college admissions professional, independent college counselor, or college counselor at a community based organization
- Must be willing to stay up-to-date on the admissions process and follow deadlines (November - March)

### TIME COMMITMENT

The AAAC volunteer position averages 2-4 hours of service per month during the interview season (November - March). Time commitment may vary depending on the committee size and the number of interview requests. Each volunteer should be willing to interview at least 3-5 students from November - March.

## **SPECIFIC DUTIES**

- Agree and follow all instructions outlined in the training module and review the Admissions website (<u>admissions.duke.edu</u>) before conducting interviews and serving as a representative of Duke University
- · Contact and arrange interviews with prospective students in a timely manner
- Conduct positive and informative interviews to gather new information about the applicant and to provide the applicant with information about Duke
- Write, complete, and submit informative and detailed evaluations for each interview by deadline
- Remain in contact with the local AAAC Chairperson
- Contact "admitted" students to congratulate them upon their acceptance to Duke and encourage their attendance at Blue Devil Days
- Participate in local college day/night programs that are pre-arranged by the Admissions Office when available
- Present fair, realistic and positive impression of Duke to prospective students, parents, and high school guidance counselors
- Attend local send-off party if available and space permits

#### **RESTRICTIONS**

An AAAC Volunteer is not eligible to participate if their child is a senior in high school and applying to Duke.

The Director of the Alumni Admissions Program reserves the right to review and restrict participation.
